

Oil the connecting rod, and install the piston. The arrow on the piston crown must point of the front of the engine.




- 6. Oil the piston pin, and install it in the piston. Be sure the piston pin clip is correctly seated in the groove.
- 7. Oil the piston, and install the cylinder onto the crankcase. Use a new cylinder gasket.
- 8. Install cylinder head gasket and cylinder head. Working in a crisscross pattern, tighten head nuts in two steps.

Head nut torque:

First: 20 Nm (2.0 m·kg, 14 ft·lb) Final: 25 Nm (2.5 m·kg, 18 ft·lb)



- 9. Clean the mating surface of cylinder and joint.
- Coat the mating surfaces of the intake manifold with Three Bond No. 50 and install new intake manifold gaskets.



11. Install intake manifold.

Tightening torque
11 Nm (1.1 m·kg, 8 ft·lb)
